

FAQs

Q: How do I apply for YouthLink?

A: Call HopeLink's office Monday-Thursday to express your interest for the YouthLink program. If there is still availability your name will be added to the list and a case manager will call you to schedule an appointment. While you are waiting for your appointment, you may download the application from our website and bring it with you to your appointment.

Q: How much assistance does the YouthLink program provide?

A: The YouthLink Program can pay for up to \$200 per child.

Q: What does the YouthLink financial assistance cover?

A: YouthLink assistance may cover any extra-curricular activity such as an organized sport or summer program your child may be interested in such as swimming or karate or gymnastics or hockey. It may also cover the required supplies to participate in the activity depending on the cost of registration.

Q: Does YouthLink pay for after school Safety Link, or day care? No, it does not. The City of Henderson can assist you with resources for those activities.

Q: What is the income requirement for the YouthLink program?

A: The YouthLink program is open to families who fall under 80% of the annual median income. This means This varies depending on how many people are in your home. See below for a guideline:

Q: What is the residency requirement for the YouthLink program?

A: The YouthLink program is open to residents of Henderson, Boulder City, and the Southeast Las Vegas zip codes of 89183, 89123 and 89122.

Q: What documents should I bring to my appointment?

A: Current ID, birth certificates for children, lease or utility bill in your name, proof of income for the past 30 days, registration information for the extracurricular program of your choice

Q: If my child is receiving financial assistance through the City of Henderson, are we eligible for assistance through HopeLink?

A: Yes, if you received assistance through the City of Henderson and it does not cover all of the fees or needs associated with the activity or sport, you are eligible to request assistance through YouthLink to be used towards the same program to cover fees but must let HopeLink know about the other assistance received.

Q: How many times may I receive YouthLink financial assistance?

A: At this time, YouthLink financial assistance will only be provided one time per household so we can assist as many families as possible based on our available funding, but the funding is available to each child in a household who wishes to participate in an activity or organized sport during the same time frame. (Spring registration, summer registration...).
